Let's Camp Lion Adventure Loop

If you would like your Scout to work on earning the Let's Camp Lion Adventure Loop at the Pack Camping Trip at Two Rivers State Recreation Area on May 17-18, please complete the following activities with your Scout at home before the campout begins. This Adventure Loop has four requirements.

1. Watch the video about the buddy system with your Scout: <u>https://vimeo.com/498051032</u>. Note that the hyperlink has been edited/shortened and so please click on it directly rather than typing it manually.

2. Explain to your Scout that the buddy system is when two Cub Scouts work together, share, and keep each other safe. Tell them that having a buddy is especially important when you are doing an activity outdoors, particularly near or on the water. Next, have your Scout complete page 47 in the Lion Handbook (your Scout is technically still a Lion until May 31). This will fulfill Requirement 1.

3. Guide your Scout as he completes page 48 and 49 in his Handbook. Once he is finished, pull up a weather app on your phone and set the location for where the campout will be held. Look for the forecast for the dates of the campout. Discuss with your Scout what he will need to bring on the campout based on the forecast. This will fulfill Requirement 2.

4. Talk with your Scout about the Cub Scout Six Essentials: water bottle, small first aid kit, whistle, flashlight, sunscreen, and trail mix. Discuss with your Scout what makes each of these six items essential when going on an outdoor adventure. Have these items available at your home and while packing for the campout, make sure that your Scout packs the Six Essentials and brings them to the campout. This will fulfill Requirement 3.

5. Scan or photograph the completed pages 47 and 48 in your Scout's Handbook and take a photo of your Scout with the Six Essentials. Email or text these scans/photos to your Den Leader as proof that your Scout completed Requirements 1-3.

6. The last requirement for this loop, Requirement 4, will be fulfilled just by attending the Pack Camping Trip. Once your Scout has attended the campout, then the Pack will inform your Scout's Den Leader that he has completed these requirements.
