

Earth Rocks (On Your Own)



Earth Rocks is an elective adventure. If a Scout chooses to earn it, and missed the June 23 Den Meeting, please complete these tasks **prior to April 1, 2026**.

Tasks to Complete:

1. Read pages 212-214 in the Webelos Handbook. Name the three rock types to your parents and explain to them how each type is formed.
2. Read page 215. Find a rock and, with your parent's help and using safety glasses, break the rock apart with a hammer. Use a magnifying glass to look at the rock pieces.
3. Read pages 216-219 and then, with your parent's help, find objects around your home to create your own Moh's Hardness Scale test. Possible objects include: a nail or screw, a piece of chalk, a rock, a penny, a piece of glass, a piece of ceramic tile, a piece of drywall, or any other objects around you home that have different hardness levels. Test your objects by scratching them with each other and then put the objects in order from hardest to softest. **Have a photo taken of you testing your objects and send it to me.**
4. Read pages 220-223 and, with your parent's help, follow the directions to grow a crystal. **Have a photo taken of you while you are making your crystal and send it to me.**
