Bobcat is a required adventure. If a Scout missed the September 24 Den Meeting, then he must complete these seven tasks below **prior to December 1, 2025**.

Tasks to Complete:

1. *Read pages 37-40 in the Webelos Handbook. You must memorize and be able to recite the Scout Oath and the Scout Law. **Before the deadline, make arrangements to recite these to me.**
2. Explain the general meaning of each of the Scout Laws to your parent and explain why each is important.
3. Read pages 44-45 and learn the Cub Scout Sign, Cub Scout Salute, and Cub Scout Handshake and learn when each is used. **Before the deadline, make arrangements to show each of these to me and explain when they are used.**
4. Read pages 41. With your parent, create a Den Meeting Code of Conduct by listing the ways you believe Webelos must behave during a Den Meeting. Discuss with your parent why each rule on the list is important. **Please take a photo of your Code of Conduct and send it to me.**
5. You must learn the names of the Scouts in the Webelos Den. **Before the deadline, make arrangements to name everyone to me.**
6. Read pages 42-43. Make sure that you are signed up to be the Denner at a Den Meeting.
7. A Scout's parent/guardian, must read the booklet, "How to Protect Your Children from Child Abuse: A Parent's Guide," found using the QR code on page 46 of the Webelos Handbook.
