

Let's Camp Tiger Adventure Loop

If you would like your Scout to work on earning the Let's Camp Tigers Adventure Loop at the Pack Camping Trip at Two Rivers State Recreation Area on May 17-18, please complete the following activities with your Scout at home before the campout begins. This Adventure Loop has five requirements.

1. Watch the video about the buddy system with your Scout: <https://vimeo.com/498051032>. Note that the hyperlinks on this page have been edited/shortened and so please click on them directly rather than typing them manually.
2. Explain to your Scout that the buddy system is when two Cub Scouts work together, share, and keep each other safe. Tell them that having a buddy is especially important when you are doing an activity outdoors, particularly near or on the water. Next, have your Scout complete the following Buddy System activity sheet and then your Scout will have fulfilled Requirement 1: <https://filestore.scouting.org>
3. Turn to page 42 in the Tiger Handbook (your Scout is technically still a Tiger until May 31). Have your Scout complete this page. Once he is finished, pull up a weather app on your phone and set the location for where the campout will be held. Look for the forecast for the dates of the campout. Discuss with your Scout what he will need to bring on the campout based on the forecast. This will fulfill Requirement 2.
4. Watch the video about the Six Essentials with your Scout: <https://vimeo.com/498051015>
5. Talk with your Scout about the Cub Scout Six Essentials: water bottle, small first aid kit, whistle, flashlight, sunscreen, and trail mix. Discuss with your Scout what makes each of these six items essential when going on an outdoor adventure. Next, turn to page 43 in the Tiger Handbook. Next, have your Scout complete page 43 in the Handbook. This will fulfill Requirement 3.
6. Scan or photograph the completed Buddy System activity sheet and complete pages 42 and 43 in your Scout's Handbook and email or text them to your Den Leader as proof that your Scout completed Requirements 1-3.
7. When you arrive at the Pack Camping Trip, please see one the Pack Adult Members for the directions for Requirement 4. It involves having your Scout help choose a good tent location and assist in setting up the tent.
8. The last requirement for this loop, Requirement 5, will be fulfilled just by attending the Pack Camping Trip. Once your Scout has helped set up your tent and attended the campout, then the Pack will inform your Scout's Den Leader that he has completed these requirements.
